This profile was updated in 1993 to show the Queen at 64 years old and then again in 2005 to show the 79-year-old Queen. A large maple leaf with finely drawn details is featured on the reverse of this gold bullion coin. The maple leaf is known around the globe as a symbol of Canada's heritage and pride.

On the reverse of all the Gold Maple Leaf coins, the content of Fine Gold and the weight of 1 oz. Or Pur are featured below the maple leaf. The purity can be seen on each side of the maple leaf of the reverse, with .999 for the common date coins and .9999 for coins such as the 2015 and 2016 1 oz. Gold Canadian Maple Leaf coins. The .999 common date Gold Maple Leaf coins feature their date and face value of \$50 on the obverse side, below the Queen's portrait.

Micro-engraving is used to create a maple leaf privy mark showing the year, such as "15" for the 2015 Gold Canadian Maple Leaf coin. The privy mark is only visible under magnification.

Radial lines machined by the RCM add another layer of security on both the obverse and reverse of this .9999 pure gold coin. All Gold Canadian Maple Leaf coins from the RCM are backed by the Canadian government.
