The Canada Gold Maple Leaf coin has been a favorite of investors since its introduction in 1979. At the time, the only gold bullion coin was the Gold Krugerrand. The Krugerrand had fallen out of favor in many circles at that time because an economic boycott of South Africa due to its policy of apartheid. The Canada Gold Maple Leaf offered bullion buyers an option to buy coins from a country that was well-respected throughout the world. Then and now, the Maple Leaf has been a strong and solid investment choice.

The Maple Leaf, designed at the Royal Canadian Mint, features the image of Queen Elizabeth II, its year and its face value on the obverse. The reverse of the coin is an illustration of the iconic Canadian maple leaf, symbolizing Canada and echoed throughout Canadian life in the flag, a national song and a wide variety of consumer products.

Since the coin was designed in 1979, the Queen's portrait has been updated twice, originally showing the 39-year-old Queen, and then the 64-year-old Queen in 1990, followed by the 79-year-old Queen in 2005. The overall design of the coin has not changed significantly since 1979, except for added security features.

This 24-karat gold coin, with its milled edge, is a somewhat delicate coin that needs to be protected from handling marks. Yet, as an investment, the Canadian Maple Leaf is a rock-solid investment.
