The France Gold 20 Franc French Rooster has been one of the most popular world coins since it was first minted in 1899. Collectors enjoy the boldness of the French rooster, a symbol France after the defeat of Napoleon III and an expression of the tenacious spirit of the French Revolution.

The obverse J.C. Chaplain design, a bust of France's national symbol Marianne based on the Roman goddess Ceres, is also a beautiful reminder of the national identity of France. Marianne has become a noted symbol of French abundance and prosperity.

The Paris Mint has existed at least since 864 and is the most important mint in France. As the producer of intriguing coins such as the Gold 20 Franc French Rooster, it has gained fame throughout the world, especially within the last century.

French Roosters contain 0.1867 troy ounces of Gold with a purity of .900, both of which are guaranteed by the French government.
